Since January 2001, Ms. Hall has served as Deputy Commissioner for Program Administration of the Alabama Medicaid Agency. In this capacity she is responsible for oversight of development, implementation, and ongoing operation of Medicaid program policies. She advises the Commissioner on matters pertaining to program policy and coverage so that services available to beneficiaries are provided appropriately and efficiently in keeping with Agency goals while meeting the requirements of federal and state regulations. Prior to her current position Ms. Hall served as director for the Medical Services Division and the Program Integrity Division.
